Mr Darcy voted UK's best looking bloke

ROMANTIC hero Mr Darcy has beaten two versions of super spy James Bond to become Britain's Best Looking Bloke, a survey said.

Colin Firth, who played Jane Austen's hero in the BBC's *Pride & Prejudice*, topped the poll, with actor Rupert Everett in second place. Clive Owen and Russell Brand came third and fourth.

Around 1,500 women voted in the poll for *Wizard Jeans*, which put Daniel Craig, who debuted as Bond in *Casino Royale* in 2006, in fifth place and former Bond star Sir Sean Connery in ninth place.

Alongside the usual suspects such as David Beckham at number 11 and Orlando Bloom at number 12, four MPs including the Prime Minister and Deputy Prime Minister also made the top 30.

Nick Clegg was voted in 27th place with David Cameron three places behind him.

Sally Allen of *Wizard Jeans* said: "I've heard girls talking about Colin Firth's brooding good looks when they are probably referring to his demeanour and grooming. That's something you can work on."
